

**RESOLUTION NO. 2011-4**

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CONEWAGO, DAUPHIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, CONCERNING A REFERENDUM ON THE QUESTION "SHOULD TWO ADDITIONAL SUPERVISORS BE ELECTED TO SERVE IN THIS TOWNSHIP?"

WHEREAS a group of residents has requested the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Conewago, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania, to consider adoption of a resolution calling for a referendum on the question "Should two additional supervisors be elected to serve in this township?";

WHEREAS the Township has previously considered this question and rejected it by an overwhelming margin;

WHEREAS the Board of Supervisors has determined that a three member Board of Supervisors is more efficient, more cost effective and less likely to lead to increases in spending and taxation than a five member board;

THEREFOR IT IS RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Conewago, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania, that there should NOT be a referendum on the question "Should two additional supervisors be elected to serve in this township?" placed on the ballot this November.
