The Conewago Township Board of Supervisors will receive bids for **the Conewago Township Park - Phase II project. Bids may be submitted and updated online until Friday, June 06, 2014, at 2:00 PM.** At that time bids will be made available online. All documents and solicitation details are available any time at [www.ebidexchange.com/pennbid](http://www.ebidexchange.com/pennbid). Click on the "Solicitations" then "View" tabs.

The work will include, but will not necessarily be limited to, providing all labor, materials, equipment, and appurtenances for the construction of the following:

Construct a recreational area with amenities including but not limited to the following base bid items: one baseball/softball field, 2 U-10 soccer fields, walking trail, parking lot and stormwater facilities; and the following alternate items: playgrounds (2), paving for parking lot, landscaping, soccer goals/markers; and other items as further described in the contract documents.

A certified check or bid bond for the amount of 10% of the total bid shall be required. Bonds are to be issued by a surety licensed to do business in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania .

Interested bidders need to register at the PennBID web-site. Once registered, bidders can obtain all project documents and submit and update their bids online. A pre-bid meeting will not be held for this project. Only those questions submitted online via PennBID shall be considered. Questions received after 2:00 on Friday, May 30, 2014 regarding the project will not be acknowledged.

Bids shall remain open for a period of 60 days from the date of Bid opening. Bids may not be withdrawn during this period. All Bidders must bid on all items listed on the Bid Form and on each bidding alternative. The successful Bidder shall be required to furnish performance and payment bonds in the amount of 100% of the Contract Price.

This contract is subject to the following: the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act conditions; the Federal Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970 (OSHA) conditions; the Pennsylvania Act 229 of 2002; the Pennsylvania One Call Act, also known as the Underground Utility Line Protection Law, Act 287 of 1974, as amended; the Pennsylvania Human Relations Act 222 Conditions; the non-discrimination in Employment/Contract Compliance Regulations Conditions; Public Works Employment Verification Act; the Universal Accessibility Act, and Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) of 1990, as amended.
