RESOLUTION NO. 2009-7

THIS RESOLUTION, approved and adopted by the Supervisors of Conewago Township, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania, on the date hereinafter set forth.

WITNESS TO:

WHEREAS, Section 7503 of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code, 35 Pa. C.S. Section 7101 et seq. mandates that Conewago Township prepare, maintain and keep current an emergency operations plan for the prevention and minimization of injury and damage caused by a major emergency or disaster within this Township; and

WHEREAS, in response to the mandate stated above, Dauphin County has prepared an emergency operations plan to provide prompt and effective emergency response procedures to be followed in the event of a major emergency or disaster;

NOW, THEREFORE, we, the undersigned Supervisors of Conewago Township do hereby approve, adopt and place into immediate effect the Emergency Operations Plan of Dauphin County. This Plan shall be reviewed every two years to make certain that it conforms to the requirements of the Dauphin County Emergency Operations Guideline.

DECLARATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on or about _____ a (disaster) has caused or threatens to cause injury, damage, and suffering to the persons and property of Conewago Township; and

WHEREAS, the (disaster) has endangered the health, safety and welfare of a substantial number of persons residing in Conewago Township, and threatens to create problems greater in scope than Conewago Township, may be able to resolve; and

WHEREAS, emergency management measures are required to reduce the severity of this disaster and to protect the health, safety and welfare of affected residents in Conewago Township;

NOW, THEREFORE, we, the undersigned Supervisors, Conewago Township pursuant to the provisions of Section 7501 of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code, (35 PA C.S., Section 7501), as amended, do hereby declare the existence of a disaster emergency in Conewago Township;

FURTHER, we direct the Conewago Township Emergency Management Coordinator to coordinate the activities of the emergency response, to take all appropriate action needed to alleviate the effects of this disaster, to aid in the restoration of essential public services, and to take any other emergency response action deemed necessary to respond to this emergency.

STILL FURTHER, we authorize officials of _____ to act as necessary to meet the current exigencies of this emergency, namely: by the employment of temporary workers, by the rental of equipment, by the purchase of supplies and materials, and by entering into such contracts and agreements for the performance of public work as may be required to meet the emergency, all without regard to those time-consuming procedures and formalities normally prescribed by law, mandatory constitutional requirements excepted.

This Declaration shall take effect immediately and last until 12-31-11.
